Itinerary:

Lumbinī (Nepali and Sanskrit: "the lovely") is a Buddhist pilgrimage site in the Rupandehi District of Nepal. It is the place where, according to Buddhist tradition, Queen Mayadevi gave birth to Siddhartha Gautama in 563 BCE. Gautama, who achieved Enlightenment sometime around 528 BCE, became the Buddha and founded Buddhism. Lumbini is one of many magnets for pilgrimage that sprang up in places pivotal to the life of the Buddha.

Lumbini has a number of temples, including the Mayadevi Temple and several others which are still under repair. Many monuments, monasteries and a museum, the Lumbini International Research Institute, are also within the holy site. Also there is the Puskarini, or Holy Pond, where the Buddha's mother took the ritual dip prior to his birth and where he had his first bath. At other sites near Lumbini, earlier Buddha's were, according to tradition, born, then achieved ultimate Enlightenment and finally relinquished their earthly forms.

Lumbini was made a World Heritage Site status by UNESCO in 1997

Day 01: Transfer from hotel to Kathmandu domestic airport to fly to Bhairahawa. Upon arrival in Bhairahawa airport transfer to hotel. Lunch. After lunch sightseeing of Lumbini Garden. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel.



Day 02: Breakfast. After breakfast transfer to Bhairahawa airport to fly back to Kathmandu. Upon arrival in Kathmandu airport transfer to hotel.
