Itinerary:

Royal Chitwan National Park is the first national park in Nepal. It was established in 1973 and granted the status of a World Heritage Site in 1984. It covers an area of 932 km² (360 sq mi) and is located in the subtropical Inner Terai lowlands of south-central Nepal. Since the end of the 19th century Chitwan – *Heart of the Jungle* – used to be a favorite hunting ground for Nepal's ruling class during the cool winter seasons. Until the 1950s, the journey from Kathmandu to Nepal's south was arduous as the area could only be reached by foot and took several weeks. Comfortable camps were set up for the feudal big game hunters and their entourage, where they stayed for a couple of months shooting hundreds of tigers, rhinoceroses, leopards and sloth bears.

Day 01: Kathmandu --- Chitwan drive (170kms, 5-6hrs drive)

Drive to Chitwan. Check-in at the Hotel. Lunch. After lunch Jungle activities. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel.



Day 02: Chitwan

Whole day jungle activities with breakfast, lunch and dinner. Overnight at the Hotel.



Day 03: Chitwan ---- Kathmandu drive

Breakfast. After breakfast drive back to Kathmandu.
